Director's Report

Renovation

There is \$399,924 in the COA capital budget for the foundation repair and waterproofing which is from the estimate provided by Engberg Anderson (from last month). This did not get into the capital budget. So, the expectation is we will be addressing this when we commence renovating.

Budget

November 15 is the City of Ashland budget meeting. I don't expect any changes to our request.

Services


Candid, the foundation directory source has some individual levels of subscription which may be a better and more affordable fit for the VPL in the next year. I did not get a very enthusiastic or overwhelming response from the postcards I sent to area non-profits. In conversation with the Superior library director, they no longer offer any similar database because use of the previous ones was low and there is on-site access is available at UW-Superior (not Candid, but something comparable). So, for \$400/annual, I can access the foundation directory essentials to search for grants that would be a potential fit for our renovation.
